

**FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

VIA VIDEO TELECONFERENCE

Chairman Dymond called the Regular Meeting of the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors to order on Thursday, May 6, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., via video teleconference.

Motion was made by Mr. Williams, seconded by Ms. McDermott to waive the reading of the minutes of the April 1, 2021 Regular Meeting and to accept the minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

MEETING OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS ONLY.

There was no public comment on agenda items.

Mr. Melvin gave the Treasurers report reciting the combined balances for all funds as of April 30, 2021 totaled \$629,495.15. Ms. McDermott made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams to approve the April 2021 Treasurers report, to approve payment of expenses totaling \$ 21,662.73 and to approve payrolls and payroll taxes in the amount of \$ 13,181.49. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Motion was made by Mr. Williams, seconded by Ms. McDermott to approve an application for minimum use driveway for Lot #1 of the Monk major subdivision. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Motion was made by Mr. Williams, seconded by Ms. McDermott to approve an application for minimum use driveway for Lot #2 of the Monk major subdivision. The motion passed unanimously.
4. Motion was made by Mr. Williams, seconded by Ms. McDermott to approve a Sewage Facilities Planning Module for the Monk major subdivision. The motion passed unanimously.
