

**FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Vice Chairman Williams called the Regular Meeting of the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors to order on Thursday, July 7, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

There were no comments on agenda items.

Motion was made by Mr. Owen, seconded by Mr. Pitcavage to appoint Eric Williams as Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. The motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Mr. Owen, seconded by Mr. Pitcavage to waive the reading of the minutes of the June 2, 2022 Regular Meeting and to accept the minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Melvin gave the Treasurers report reciting the combined balances for all funds as of June 30, 2022 totaled \$833,931.33. Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Owen to approve the June 2022 Treasurers report, to approve payment of expenses totaling \$72,393.58 and to approve payrolls and payroll taxes in the amount of \$ 15,095.07. The motion passed unanimously.

1. Motion to approve a driveway permit for 768 Lewis Road was tabled until a future date.
2. Motion was made by Mr. Owen, seconded by Mr. Pitcavage to schedule a special meeting for July 21, 2022 to open storage building bids. The motion passed unanimously.
3. Motion was made by Mr. Williams, seconded by Mr. Owen to accept a bid amount of \$5,085.00 and approve the sale of a Ford tractor with mower. The motion passed unanimously.
4. Motion was made by Mr. Owen, seconded by Mr. Pitcavage to authorize Secretary/Treasurer Melvin to sign appropriate documentation to complete the sale and transfer of the Ford tractor. The motion carried unanimously.
